LEARNING COMMUNITY

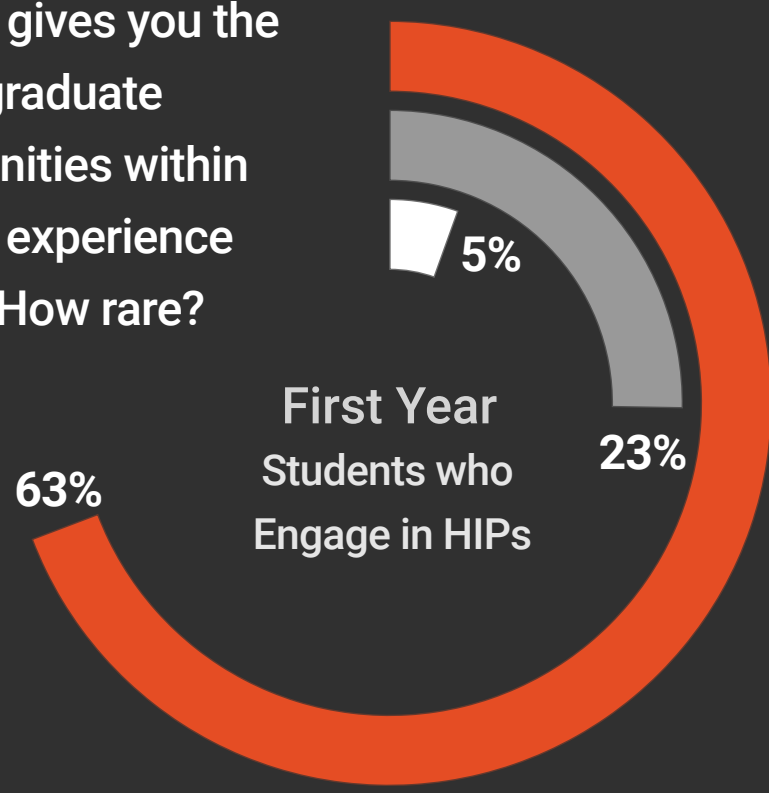


Formal program where groups of students take 2+ classes together

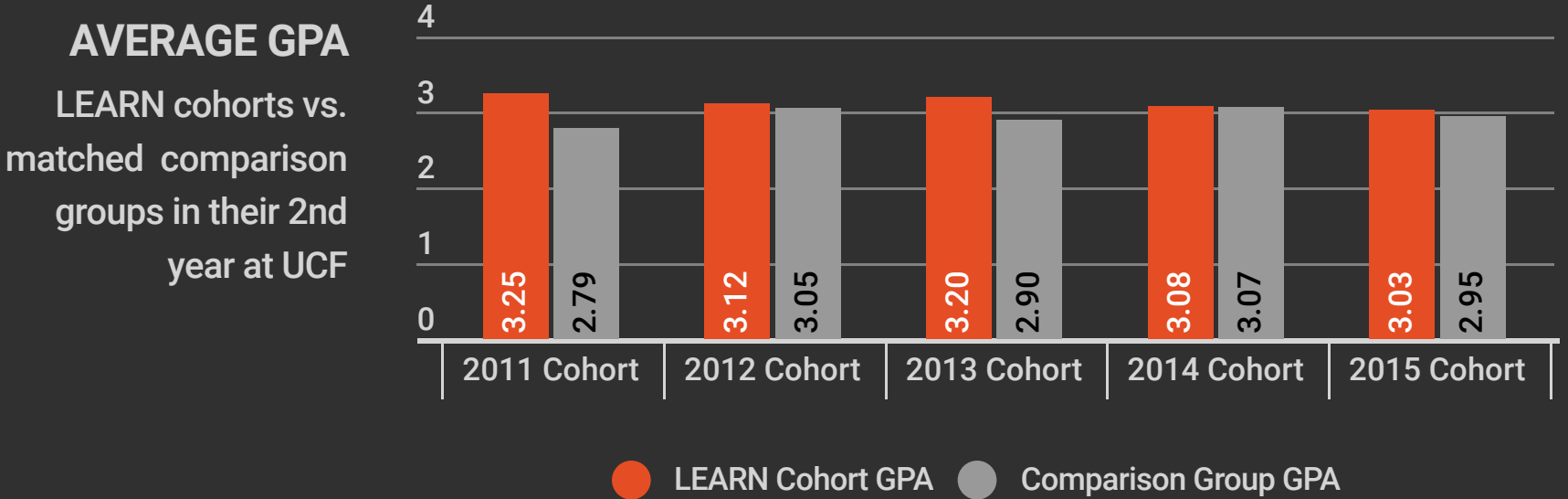
